**When is it held?** Wednesdays: 10/11, 11/1, 12/20, 1/17, 2/7, 3/21

**When is the museum trip?** Friday, April 13

**Where will the sessions be held?** at Westorchard Elementary School

**What is the cost?** \$90 for one parent and one child, \$30 for a second child (from the same family) and no charge for any additional children (or parent) from the same family. Transportation and admission to the Met is not included (any family requiring financial assistance should contact your school principal)
